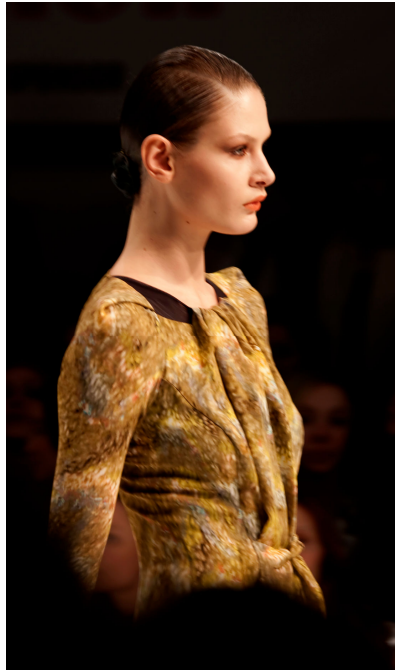

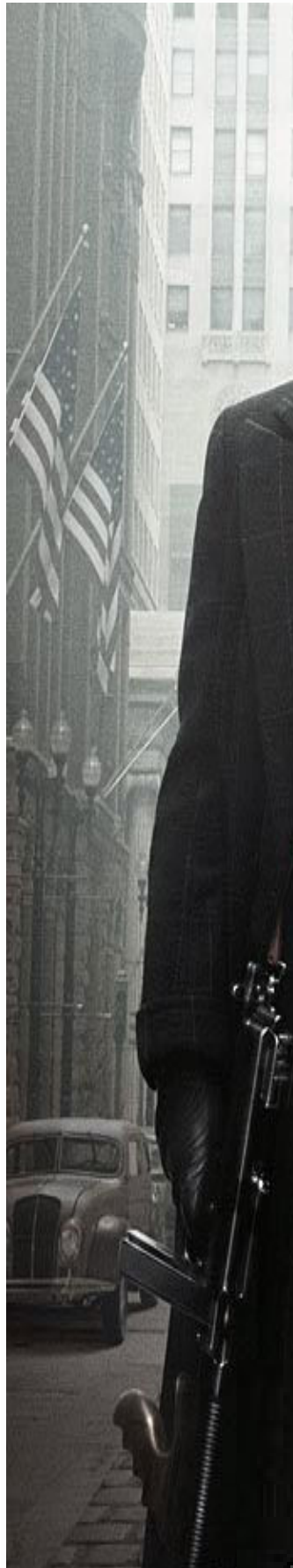


### Ronnie Rock's Birthday Ball

- There was a mixed picture emerging from the second quarter of this year. France and Germany's economies returned to growth, although Spain and Italy's economies continued to shrink.

- In the UK and US, central bankers reacted positively saying that economic activity was improving and there were expectations of a return to growth, albeit muted, in the coming months.

- In the UK, consumers are feeling more confident judging by the increased activity in the housing market and healthy high street sales in July.

With signs of life beginning to appear, it was unsurprising that in response to better economic news overall global markets continued their strong run.

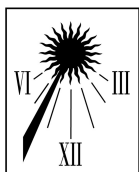
