chandeliered splendour of Porchester Hall in Bayswater, London.

In Ceroc's early days there were no formal dance classes. A group of taxi dancers (the girls in full, taffeta skirts and the boys wearing white jeans and shirts) were on hand to help beginners, while dancers helped themselves to free buckets of lemonade and squash. Today, Ceroc is the largest and fastest growing contemporary partner dance in the UK.

So join us for a lively, fun-filled evening of Ceroc instruction and dance, courtesy of Tuca Dance Company. We meet from 7.30pm onwards. 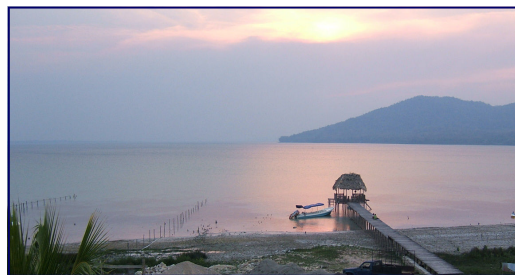

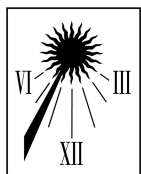
